

# Under Age Queen Contestants

As a contestant in the Queen Division, I understand that I am under age to participate in the State Fair Contest. If I should have enough points to win the Wayne County 4-H Fair Queen title, State Fair rules state that an age appropriate contestant must be 18 as of June 1<sup>st</sup> of the year they will reign, if chosen as Miss Indiana State Fair.

As an under aged contestant, I have two (2) choices to participate in the contest:

\_\_\_\_\_ 1. If I have enough points to win the title of Wayne County 4-H Fair Queen, I choose to retain the title and forfeit the opportunity to attend State Fair. State Fair rules state that a contestant can only win their county fair title one (1) time. I understand that I will not be able to participate in a future County Queen contest or attend State Fair.

\_\_\_\_\_ 2. If I have enough points to win the title of Wayne County 4-H Fair Queen, I choose to forfeit the title, so that I may participate in another County contest to have the opportunity to attend State Fair when I am of age. I understand that I must participate in another county queen contest and there is no guarantee that I may win the Queen title at a later time.

As an under aged queen contestant, I have made the above choice if I should be chosen as the Wayne County 4-H Queen. The above decision cannot be changed after the judging has begun, on the Saturday of the contest. If I choose to change my decision, a revised form must be signed by me and my parent for acknowledgment. The decision, based on this form, is final.
