Under Age Queen Contestants

As a contestant in the Queen Division, I understand that I am under age to participate in the State Fair Contest. If I should have enough points to win the Wayne County 4-H Fair Queen title, State Fair rules state that an age appropriate contestant must be 18 as of June 1st of the year they will reign, if chosen as Miss Indiana State Fair.

As an under aged contestant, I have two (2) choices to participate in the contest:

- 1. If I have enough points to win the title of Wayne County 4-H Fair Queen, I choose to retain the title and forfeit the opportunity to attend State Fair. State Fair rules state that a contestant can only win their county fair title one (1) time. I understand that I will not be able to participate in a future County Queen contest or attend State Fair.
- 2. If I have enough points to win the title of Wayne County 4-H Fair Queen, I choose to forfeit the title, so that I may participate in another County contest to have the opportunity to attend State Fair when I am of age. I understand that I must participate in another county queen contest and there is no guarantee that I may win the Queen title at a later time.

As an under aged queen contestant, I have made the above choice if I should be chosen as the Wayne County 4-H Queen. The above decision cannot be changed after the judging has begun, on the Saturday of the contest. If I choose to change my decision, a revised form must be signed by me and my parent for acknowledgment. The decision, based on this form, is final.
